Mission Statement:

Wayne PAL Lacrosse is organized for and committed to the purpose of instilling, developing, and nurturing the love of lacrosse. While also promoting good sportsmanship, honesty, loyalty, respect, sense of teamwork and strong work ethic so our players will not only be successful athletes but also more importantly become strong, healthy, well-adjusted members of the community.

Parent Expectation:

We'd like your support as volunteers, team parents, and assistant coaches. We'd also appreciate your boy(s) arriving on time, fully dressed, with all the right equipment in all the right places. We also expect our parents to lead by example and demonstrate great sportsmanship towards our opponents, referees, and fans. The program has been built on volunteerism.

VOLUNTEERING: In order to keep per player costs low, we do require all families to volunteer in at least one area. This includes, but is not limited to: staffing Bingo, apparel distribution, fundraising, and event staff. If you would like your child to play, you must be prepared to help!

Coaches Responsibilities:

Our coaches are unpaid volunteers who spend up to 300 hours per year making this program work. They work full time and take the time to ensure all our players develop and learn the game of lacrosse, while teaching the players to treat their teammates, opponents, and officials with respect. They also attend coaching clinics to enable them to help our boys even more.

PROGRAM GOALS All players who attend practice and follow the program rules, play. We are dedicated to fair and consistent treatment of all players. Our volunteer coaching staff is committed to creating a strong fundamental base for all participants.

Higher level boys travel teams for the 6th, 7th and 8th grades and players will be selected based upon tryouts (dates TBD). All players not selected to the travel teams will be placed on the regular teams at their grade level. As always everyone plays, and no prior Lacrosse experience is necessary. We do reserve the right to limit roster size at a level to ensure a quality experience for all.

Boys Program | $3_{rd} - 8_{th}$ Grade Boys. We play a full travel schedule with games in and out of town each week during the season. These teams will be playing March through early June, with games and practices 3-4 nights per week. For tournaments, coaches reserve the right to play with shorter rosters to ensure competitiveness. We try to schedule at least 10 games for each level but cannot guarantee it.

Girls Program | 3rd – 8th Grade Girls. All girls in the program will play in our in-town rec games as well as participating in 1 to 2 practices each week. All girls will also play games on our Travel Team however the number of travel games each girl plays may be based on their commitment level as well as their skill level. All girls in the program will be treated fairly. There may also be some Select Games for our most advanced and committed players. Our focus will be on improving the skill level of all girls while having fun, making friends and growing a love of lacrosse.

US LACROSSE | All players and coaches **must** be registered with US Lacrosse prior to stepping on the field. US Lacrosse provides insurance for all players and coaches when participating in any practice, game and/or tournament play. The cost is \$25 for Youth Players, \$35 for High School Players and \$50 for Adults. In addition to the insurance benefits, members receive a monthly edition of Lacrosse Magazine and periodic discounts for lacrosse related items, services and events. EQUIPMENT

Boys' Program | Field players are required to wear a helmet, shoulder pads, arm guards, gloves, mouth guard and athletic supporter. Goalies are required to wear a helmet with attached throat guard, chest protector, gloves, mouth guard and athletic supporter. Sticks vary by position. We offer players in grades 3rd-5th use of all equipment except mouth guards, athletic supporters and lacrosse sticks, which are the responsibility of each player. Grades 6th-8th can rent for \$50 additional

Girls' Program | Field players are required to have their own goggles, mouth guard and lacrosse stick. Goalie equipment is provided by the program.
